

Privacy Policy

Breckenridge Lettings Ltd (the "Company") is committed to complying with data protection legislation, the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), and good practice, which respects your privacy and is committed to protecting the personal information that you share with us. When we do need your personal information to provide services that you request or when you choose to provide us with personal information, this policy describes how we collect and use your personal information.

Information Collection

Personal information means any information that may be used to identify an individual, including, but not limited to, a first and last name, email address, a home, postal or other physical address, title, birth date, gender, occupation, industry, personal interests, other information when needed to provide a service you requested.

The Company collects personal information when you register with the Company for a Company account, when you use certain Company products or services, when you register to attend a seminar or other promotions, or when you submit your personal information to the Company for any other reason.

How we will use your information collected

Breckenridge Lettings is committed to complying with data protections legislation, the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and good practice including:

- We collect the minimum information about you to process your request, manage your account and, if you agree, to email you about other products and services we think may be of interest to you.
- We retain personal information only for as long as it is necessary to comply with your requests and/or legal or regulatory reasons. Retention limits are documented in the Company's Retention policy.
- We use your information collected from the website to personalise your repeat visits to our website.
- If you agree, we shall pass on your personal information to our group of companies so that we may offer you their products and services.
- Breckenridge Lettings will not share your information for marketing purposes with companies outside of Breckenridge Lettings Ltd.

Information Sharing and Disclosure

Your personal information is never shared outside the Company without your permission, except under conditions explained below.

The Company may send your personal information to other companies or people under any of the following circumstances: when we have your consent to share the information; we need to share your information to provide the product or service you have requested; we need to send the information to companies who work on behalf of the Company to provide a product or service to you (we will only provide those companies the information they need to deliver the service, and they are prohibited from using that information for any other purpose); or we want to keep you up to date on the latest product announcements, special offers or other information we think you'd like to hear about either from us or from our business partners (unless you have opted out of these types of communications). We will also disclose your personal information if required to do so by law, or in urgent circumstances, to protect personal safety, the public or our websites.

Children and Privacy

Our websites do not target and are not intended to attract children under the age of 16. The Company does not knowingly solicit personal information from children under the age of 16 or send them requests for personal information.

Third Party Sites

The Company's website contains links to other sites. The Company does not share your personal information with those websites and is not responsible for their privacy practices. We encourage you to learn about the privacy policies of those companies.

Our website may contain links to websites operated by other companies. Some of these third-party sites maybe co-branded with a Company logo, even though they are not operated or maintained by the Company.
